Dear Junior Girl Scout,

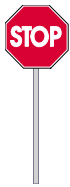
Congratulations on your decision to seek the Bronze Award.

📌 Imagine what you might want to do for your project.

📌 Share your idea with your leader.

📌 Work on Steps 1, 2 and 3 on your BRONZE AWARD PERSONAL RECORD. These three things can be done in any order. Write down what you did. For additional information, read the Junior Girl Scout Handbook.



Be sure the first three requirements are done before going to the next step.

📌 Write your ACTION PLAN for your project and have your leader check it over.



📌 GO! Do your project and fill out the PROJECT LOG as you go.



📌 When you've completed your project of at least 15 hours, complete Step #4 on the BRONZE AWARD PERSONAL RECORD.

📌 Make a copy of everything and keep one set for you. Take one set to your leader. Have her sign your papers.

📌 Attend the ceremony to get your GS Bronze Award pin. Congratulations.
