

GIRL SCOUT® NOTES

FUNDRAISING POLICY

Please be advised that the following policy shall take effect immediately for all girl scouts in Troop 535.

Fall Sales: Each Scout must sell the minimum that is asked of them. (The 2004 fall sales minimum was one (1) item at \$5.00) Plus we ask you to fill out the 10 addresses in the family book.

Cookie Sales: Each scout and one (1) parent must attend the annual cookie training meeting (usually the first meeting after Christmas break –please put this on your calendar) Each scout needs to sell at least 2/3 of the scout's goal (our 2005 cookie sale had too many people selling less than 50 boxes. If each girl only sold that many, we would not be able to do anything with our cookie money and it would be up to the parents to pay for everything.)

Cookie Booths: Each scout must participate in at least 1/4 of the total booth hours that we have setup for our troop. This includes one (1) scout and (1) of that scout's parents. (Your girl scout leaders and their daughters put in over 20 hours at the booths this year.)

If Scout's do not participate in all of the above requirements, then they will not be able to participate in any of that year's field trips, unless their parent pays for the trip out of their own pocket.

This prevents those who do not participate in fundraising from reaping all of the same benefits as those who do participate.
